

This anthology explores 8 different cases of serial killers. This book will explore the killers, their victims, and give the reader a peek into their minds. 1. DAVID PARKER RAY - The Toy Box Killer Ray was a kidnapper, rapist, torturer of women and young girls. He carried out his crimes for 40 years before finally getting caught. It is suspected that he killed at least 60, but no bodies have ever been found. You won't believe who one of his accomplices was. 2. JAMES HUBERTY - The McDonald's Massacre (San Diego) One of the most devastating rampages in modern American history. Driving through the front window of MacDonald's, he exited his vehicle and promptly started shooting the patrons. His end count was 21 dead and 19 horrifically injured. The youngest killed was 8 months old, the oldest was 74 years. 3. FRITZ HAARMANN - The Butcher of Hanover (also known as The Vampire of Hanover) Harrmann murdered, dismembered and disposed of the young men he lured to his home. He was responsible for at least 27 murders between 1918 and 1924 in Hanover, Germany. His method of murder was to bite his victim's Adam's apple. Once dead, he would dismember the body and throw the parts into a river. 4. ANATOLY ONOPRIENKO - One of the worst serial killers known. He terrorized the Ukraine as he slaughtered families in their own homes, then usually set fire to their homes. Men, women, children -- made no difference to him. When caught, he confessed to taking the lives of 52 people. 5. CHO SEUNG-HUI - Virginia Tech Massacre In 2007 this young man walked into the buildings at Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University in Virginia. Diagnosed as mentally ill when a child, his family did little more to get him the help he obviously needed. It is said he wanted to recreate what had happened at Columbine. After killing 32 teachers and students and wounding 17, he put his gun to his head and

fired a final time.6. GEORGE HENNARD - The Luby's Massacre Hennard drove his pickup truck through the glass plated front of Luby's Restaurant in Killeen, Texas. There were 80 people inside, including the staff. Instead of firing his guns randomly, he targeted mostly women first. Those who survived all mentioned how calm he seemed. There were 50 victims in total - 23 killed and 27 wounded. He was shot by police 3 times, but it was his own gun that finally took his life.7.

KENNETH BIANCHI & ANGELO BUONO - The Hillside Stranglers Between 1977 and 1978, these two cousins tortured and killed women in Los Angeles. Their trials would become the most expensive in the history of California at that time. Sexual abuse, torture, murder ... horrific acts of brutality - before disposing of their naked bodies on hillsides that dotted the area. Buono died of natural causes while behind bars. Bianchi cannot apply for parole until 2025.8 .RONALD DOMINIQUE - The Bayou Strangler Bodies of men were turning up in New Orleans, the victims of rape and murder. Before it was all over, 23 men would be dead. In his early years, it was discovered that Dominique was a homosexual. As a school student, he was bullied and teased unmercifully. As an adult, he was unattractive, unlikable and had no friends. His victims ranged in age from 17 to 46. Due to a DNA match, he was finally caught and confessed his crimes. Among some "honorable" mentions are John Wayne Gacy, Patrick Wayne Kearney. Jeffrey Dahmer, David Edward Maust, and Randy Steven Kraft. All these men were monsters who preyed on innocent people for their own guilty pleasures. In the last 50 years, there have been many incidents of men going on rampages in schools, colleges, restaurants, often with high kill rates. They often end in suicides. The killers in this book are the stuff of nightmares. The book is well-written, filled with facts not necessarily widely known. It's hard to say I liked this book some of it is hard to read, some of it extremely so. I did give it 5 stars ... even though I got up several times to check my doors and windows. Florida author Jack Rosewood inherited his fascination for heinous crimes from his father, a journalist covering major grim crimes such as Ted Bundy. He is fascinated with serial killers — their development psychologically, their preparation for their life of crime, and the details of how they made their bloody black marks on the world. Jack moves away from his intensive studies of serial killers to explore current crimes most of which are discoveries for the reader — even the Jack Rosewood reader! He is joined by co-author Rebecca Lo with whom he has published three other collections - TRUE CRIME STORIES: TRUE CRIME ANTHOLOGY - and together they survey SERIAL KILLERS — electing to share the

incredulous horror of eight serial killers. As usual Jack (and now with Rebecca) opens with an introduction explaining the decision to place these gruesome stories before us:

“The world is full of spree killers, serial killers, and mass killers, and as the population continues to grow throughout the globe, the numbers are increasing. Some consider spree and mass killers to be the worst kind of murderers - those that in one moment enter a building where there are a lot of people and open fire, killing as many as quickly as possible. But those kinds of murders are often over in a matter of minutes. Serial killers can instill fear in the communities for years, in some cases decades, and for many people, these are the worst of them all. Anatoly Onoprienko is perhaps one of the worst serial killers known so far. A cold, vicious killer, he terrorized the Ukraine as he slaughtered families in their beds at night. Then there are killers like Fritz Haarmann and Ronald Dominique who abducted, raped and killed numerous young boys and men for their own guilty pleasures. But these men aren’t that different in reality - all were monsters who preyed on innocent people, ripping them from their families and friends at their own will. Spree or mass killers have been in the news media in recent years as they seem to be occurring more often. In the last 50 years, there have been many incidents of men going on rampages in schools, universities and restaurants, with high kill rates and often ending in suicides. Cho Seung-Hui, George Hennard and James Huberty all have this in common. There were warning signs for each of them, but nobody realized the damage they were about to inflict. This book delves into eight cases involving serial, spree and mass killers, some of who are well-known and others that are perhaps not as famous. In each case we will look at the perpetrator and his background history, the crime, and examine the reasons behind the atrocities they committed. But we won’t forget about the victims either. Often the focus is on the man behind the trigger instead of the person on the receiving end of the bullet. In many of these cases, the victims’ names and details are included. The killers in this book are the stuff of nightmares. Real-life bogeymen that had the ability to strike anytime, anywhere, and without notice. They all left a trail of carnage so horrific, and a number of victims so high, that they are right at the top of the list when it comes to murderers. The crimes they committed not only changed the way people lived, but also resulted in law changes to protect the innocent, in the hopes of preventing such tragedies from occurring again.” From this terrifying introduction Jack and Rebecca address not only the back history of each of these serial killers, but also carefully describe the manner in which the killings occurred with a sense of psychological finesse that is rarely found in books such as this. We read, we learn, and we begin to understand. Easy reading? No, because of the subject matter but not the style of journalism. This is another important book from Jack
