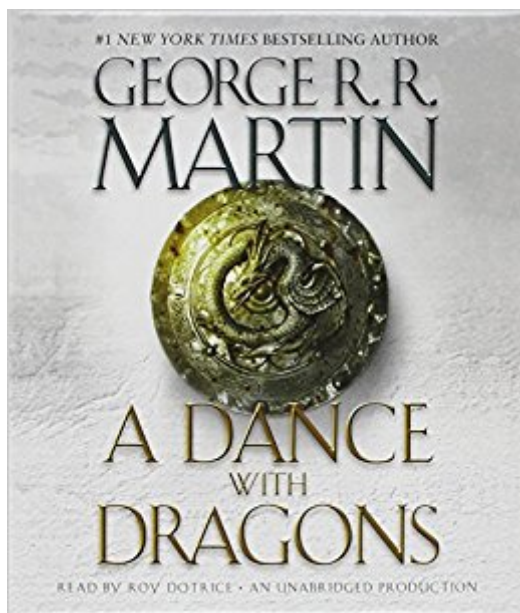


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A Dance With Dragons: A Song Of Ice And Fire: Book Five



Synopsis

George R.R. Martin sold his first story in 1971 and has been writing professionally since then. He spent ten years in Hollywood as a writer-producer, working on *The Twilight Zone*, *Beauty and the Beast*, and various feature films and television pilots that were never made. In the mid '90s he returned to prose, his first love, and began work on his epic fantasy series, *A Song of Ice and Fire*. He has been in the *Seven Kingdoms* ever since. Whenever he's allowed to leave, he returns to Santa Fe, New Mexico, where he lives with the lovely Parris, a big white dog called Mischa, and two cats named Augustus and Caligula, who think they run the place.

While I agree with some reviewers that the story does plod along very slowly in this book, I was still at all times invested in the story and overall enjoyed the book very much. GRRM is capable of holding the interest of a reader through the heavy use of dialogue, little action and very little plot development. Similar to the previous books in the series, there are stages in the book where very little happens yet I still feel compelled to read further to find out what is in store for my favourite characters as there was always something to tweak my interest. As before each chapter centres around a certain character but towards the end, the separate stories are beginning to merge and I hope that signals that some characters will be teaming up again in the near future. One minor complaint may be the increasing number of characters who are sometimes hard to keep track of. However, the attention to detail and the fleshing out of each character in their own right is indeed masterful and makes one willing to forgive the ever growing task of keeping track of these due to the enjoyment I found in getting to know them. I believe this is one of the reasons you become invested and engrossed in a slow-paced book since you live yourself into the story thanks to the immersive writing style. Be warned that, as in previous stories, GRRM is not afraid to kill off characters, which I find refreshing since the story is not predictable and the reader is never assured that a main protagonist is safe. And once again, as in previous ventures, the story accelerates sharply near the end with many cliffhangers which will surely keep readers coming back for more. I look forward to reading the conclusion in this epic series.

GRRM continues his masterpiece of a series in "*A Dance With Dragons*." While "*A Feast for Crows*" was a more laid back, "stroll through the park" type of story, "*Dance*" is a thrill ride of magic, war, politics, and suspense. With surprises around every corner, and the further development of some of

the series' most favored characters, this is easily one of the best in the series. The closing chapters only leave the reader more desperate for the next installment. This is a must-read!

All along the books in the Song Of Ice And Fire have been nothing short of magnificent and I believe glorious account of a fictional medieval time. Martins style does not follow in a standard chronological manner each chapter describes the actions of a character not necessarily following the normal progression and can be challenging to some whereas I found it easier to follow especially if reading a number of chapters in one sitting. The story is not yet complete but as I have had to re-read the Song Of Ice and Fire after watching HBO's serialised chronologically version I'm sure in my mind I will need to revisit the earlier books when reading the final (if really final) books. Highly recommended.

George R. R. Martin is a great author and his latest book, a Dance with Dragons is no exception to this rule. This novel is a real page turner and in George's fashion, you never know which beloved character may die next (Not to give away any spoilers, but we all know he is famous for this). Let's hope that George R. R. Martin will finish these books soon, we've been so anxiously awaiting book six!
