

I used it on my August 2011 trip to BA. This book was very helpful. Accurate information and good maps. It shipped quickly, giving me extra time to prepare for the trip. A +++ sales experience.

So I am living in Buenos Aires for five months and brought four guidebooks with me and have been able to "test drive" each one thoroughly while down here ... the Rough Guide is the easy winner - it simply has been spot-on in recommending the places to see, how to see them, and the best way to get there ... even its restaurant choices are astonishingly good, as the book identifies the best places to eat instead of the places that the tourists eat (often a huge difference!) ... I travel a lot and rarely give myself completely over to a guide book, but this one has me tempted to simply let it take me through the rest of my time here ... the only reason you may need an additional book if you're coming to Argentina is that this book does not cover areas more than a day trip away (it does cover Colonia/Uruguay, which is an easy ferry ride from BA, and does it splendidly) - so if you're going to do the Falls or the glaciers, you may want another book as well or do it online ... but I truly have been blown away by how good the Rough Guide is for my time down here ...

Buenos aires doesn't have much going for it, and this guide doesn't have much to talk about.

Buenos Aires is a gigantic city with a building code that restricts them to about 6 stories.
