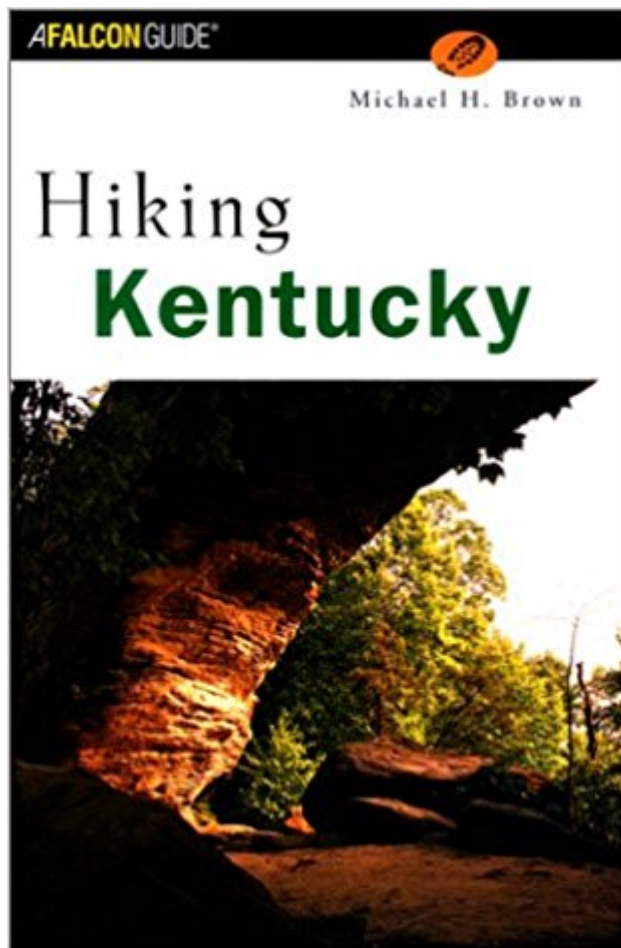

The descriptions and directions were fully accurate, and the book described clearly some of the route finding challenges on this particular trail. Highly recommended.
