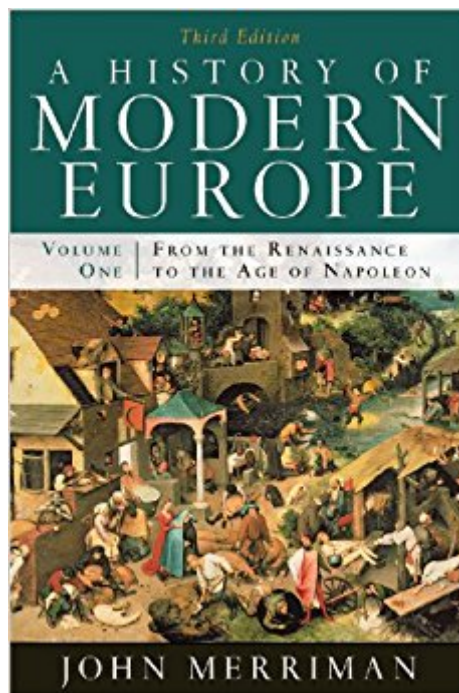




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A History Of Modern Europe: From The Renaissance To The Age Of Napoleon (Third Edition) (Vol. 1)

John Merriman is the Charles Seymour Professor of History at Yale University. A specialist in nineteenth century French history, Merriman earned his Ph. D at the University of Michigan. He is the author of many books, including *The Margins of City Life: Explorations on the French Urban Frontier, 1815–1851*; *Red City: Limoges and the French Nineteenth Century*; *The Agony of the Republic: The Repression of the Left in Revolutionary France, 1848–1851*; and, most recently, *The Stones of Balazuc: A French Village in Time* (Norton, 2002). He regularly teaches the survey of modern European history at Yale.

Although this text covers a lot of time (generally the Renaissance through twentieth century Europe) this professor has a focus on the nineteenth century. Comparatively, he spends the most amount of time discussing this time period. I would recommend this to people who are keenly interested specifically in Europe during the 19th century. It describes the changes that an emerging middle class (from the Industrial Revolution) in Europe caused with respect to the Old Regime. If you want more information on the 20th century read "Europe in the Twentieth Century" by Paxton.
