

Reading this work, which is written in the style of a classic philosophical polemic, can be a game changer. It identifies and pulls down all the masks from authoritarian ideologies, philosophies and religions and shows what they really are: devious tools invented by the few in power to prevent the many from realizing their true freedom and limitless potential. Without specifically saying so, the author comes from the long line of Scottish empiricists who reject the notion that there are "higher realities" which cannot be proven or disproven by our fallible senses; that control us and to which we should succumb our intellectual faculties in order to have a meaningful life. Instead, we are free to determine our own "fate", once we recognize the attempts to manipulate us for what they are. And there are many, some of which we might have never recognized as such, and which all have one thing in common: the presentation of alternative realities as the real truth, that can only be obtained through submission and abrogation of our innate empirical faculties: in that regard this book could not be more timely! The book is marvelously well researched and brims with original citations from such works as the Bhagavatgita to Mein Kampf, which one would have a hard time sourcing elsewhere.
