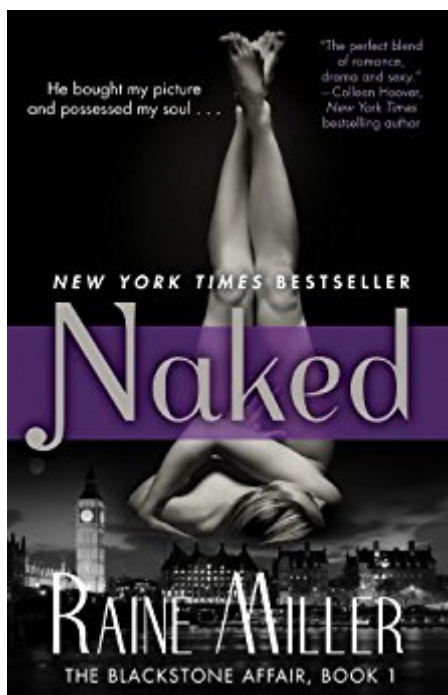


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Naked: The Blackstone Affair, Book 1

Ethan and Brynne are complex characters that readers will root for. Both are broken in some way and need to help to heal with amazing chemistry. The secondary characters are also complex enough to create successful spin offs that will have her followers adding them immediately to the TBRs. The only way I believe this could be rated higher than the 4.6 star rating I am giving it is if there was more/longer hot sex scenes, more detail into their chemistry. This book was good. This book first starts off with Ethan's POV as the prologue. I actually liked that it started off like that-leading to some background in the story. Brynne is an American girl living in London. She moves there to escape her past. She goes to university and sometimes does modeling to make extra money. While she went to support her friend and her picture at an art gallery, she meets Ethan. He does not hide the desire that he feels for her and does all that he can to meet her. Even with her issues, she manages to trust after several attempts of his pursuing her. Ethan was all-out alpha. He knew what he wanted and that was Brynne. Meanwhile, Brynne was letting down her guard and there were signs that she was falling for Ethan. She didn't know that Ethan was hired by her father- a secret that could devastate her. There were things left unsaid that were important to the story. Anyway, they continue with their relationship until we get to the cliffhanger at the end. One visit at his office changes things for this couple. The intensity between the two was palpable as I read-definitely got the sense that they were attracted to each other and somehow needed that connection. The only thing that I wanted more of was the emotional part of their relationship-an equal balance with the physical. Just to show why Ethan and Brynne had this connection. I also wanted it to be longer so that more of the story could be told. Interested to continue reading the story and find out what happens next with this couple. I'd give this 3.5 stars.
