

This book has great itineraries, word of caution, read carefully the recommended duration of each drive. In my eagerness to see France and all it's wonders I under-estimated time allotments. It all worked out though once I realized it's my trip and I can go where I want to. We would pick portions of the itineraries, middle to the end or somewhere part way. Not too many recommendations for accommodations, but there was one that saved us one night when we were in a small village and our other guide book didn't have any listing at all.
