

Yes, the middle of the book is heavy, the famous author takes you on board of the famous airplane, sharing with you his erratically jumping memories from childhood, his repeated struggle against fatigue and the irresistible desire to sleep (and die), his enormous difficulties in flying and thinking ahead. It is definitely tiring and torturing the readers, in a similar way as the circumstances were

tiring and torturing Lindbergh, but if you go through that ordeal, you can say you took part of the first solo transatlantic flight, at least spiritually.

Any aviation nut will enjoy and gain insight from this book! It might be a little slow at times, but getting an inside look into the what it took to accomplish this astonishing and incredibly dangerous feat is riveting! While the actual flight from New York to France is covered quite well in this book, the real gem is Charles' experiences leading up to that flight. Modern day pilots will definitely appreciate the techniques and general craftiness used by these trail blazing/barnstorming aviators.
