

I am not a Bible authority. This is the translation my Unitarian minister recommended. It reads easily.

This is the first Bible I have owned that included the apocrypha. I am enjoying the additional historical books.

Great version with a lot more of the deuterocanonical books than any other Bible, excepting the Ethiopic Bibles, which include the Book of Enoch (and Jubilees, I think). Apart from not having those, this is a great Bible. It's also an excellent translation, and far less driven by the politics of the far right than say the NIV is. As regards the print, it's not the largest I've seen, but it's far from the smallest, and it's well spaced. Overall, for the size of the book itself (which you can hold in your hands without being too heavy), it's pretty good. But if you're older and need reading glasses, get 'em out.

This is a nice, plain-language Holy Bible. I still much prefer the NIV. Nevertheless, I am glad that I have this because it helps me cross-reference verses.
