

This book is a wonderful starting point if you are trying to find your spirituality or explore it fully. There's two tests in the book. The first tests to see your "spiritual type" or how you show your belief. The second test is for "tradition indicator" or what you believe. The results for the second part is broken down into, I think seven faiths. The results, for me were quite accurate. The book then goes on to give brief descriptions of each faith as well as resources to do further research. I highly recommend this book if you are trying to find your spirituality.

This book I can only praise, I have used the two surveys several times in group settings. As well as borrowed to many people. The surveys are quick and easy, and give you a fairly accurate idea of your Spiritual type (which is essentially how you "believe" or "approach belief") and what type or category of religions/spiritualities you may like. In which it covers most, though leaving out Daoism, which I still find odd. This is a good book to help put someone who is seeking on probably the right path, or atleast a path which will lead them to what they seek. I highly reccomend it!

This fascinating book is quite different than any other book that I have ever read. It starts out with a

simple test that looks at your "Spiritual Identity." It allows you to question what you believe, as opposed to simply what religious group you belong to. After that, the book launches into a wide reaching description of many spiritual traditions. Hinduism and Buddhism are covered, as is Judaism. After that, the various Christian traditions are covered, as is Unitarianism. Now, does the above description sound like this book is "all over the road"? Well, it really isn't. The whole idea of the book is to question your spirituality, and look at other traditions. Overall, I found this to be a fascinating and quite eye-opening read. Even if you are not a seeker, looking for something new, you will enjoy this profound look at spirituality, and will feel your mind truly exercised. I highly recommend this book.

I found this book very nicely organized and the Self Test very useful indeed. However, I wonder why there is not even a mention of Taoism, the ancient spiritual path of China, and the basis of the increasingly popular form of "soft" martial art, Tai Chi Chuan. Some may argue that Taoism is more a philosophy, not a "religion" per se, but in some sense neither is Buddhism. Maybe the third edition could correct this omission? Otherwise, A-plus!
