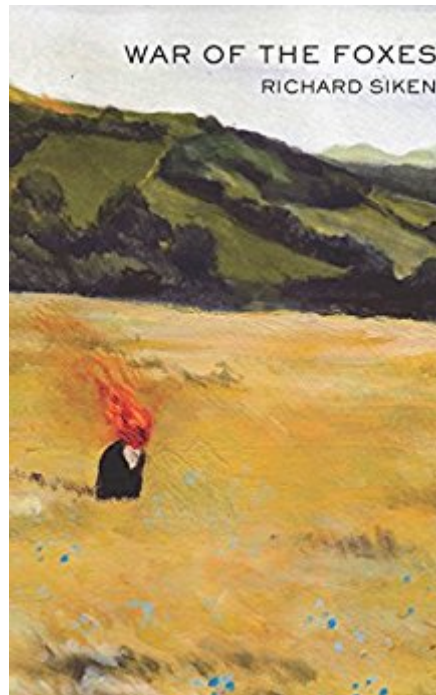

If you're buying this book based off of love for poetry and vivid view points on love and life, you've come to the right place. If you're looking for a book to come close to Siken's first book, "Crush" then maybe this isn't the right place for you. Where Siken's first book was blunt and raw, the new book is more in depth and takes some deciphering. Either way, it's filled with emotion and passion that is hard to come by in this day and age

I think this volume is going to stay with me, much like Crush did. War of the Foxes is in some ways more subtle, and the poems here took me longer to digest, but they lingered with me. The imagery is quiet, powerful, strong. If you like Siken, you already know you'll have to read this.

Siken is an incredible poet. I don't follow poetry as closely as I once did, but I'll always make sure to follow Siken. His work has the power to make me think and feel deeply in equal measures, and War of the Foxes asks a lot of important questions about the function of art and the nature of simulacra.

Richard Siken does it again! Crush holds a special place in my heart, and will always be my favorite, but this one doesn't dissappoint in the slightest.
