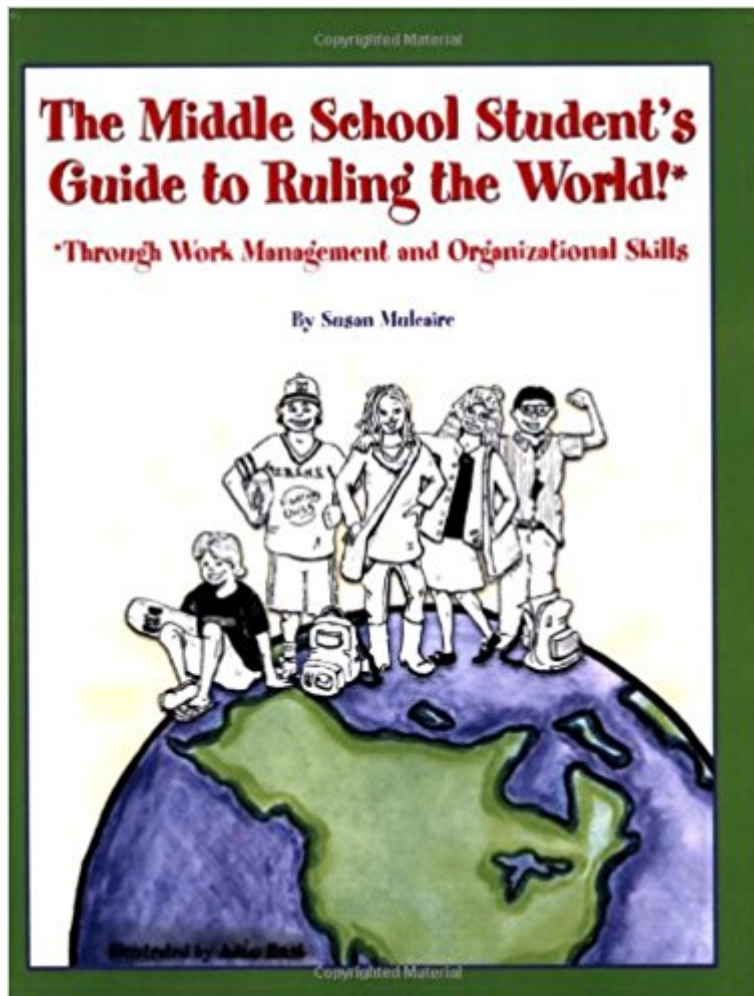

There was good information in here, but also a lot of "fluff." My 13 year old son and I read through the entire book together this summer (before he enters 7th grade, after being homeschooled for

several years) and did all of the exercises -- and though I think he learned a number of beneficial things, we were both constantly rolling our eyes at the stupidity of the "fluff." This book takes dumbing-down to a whole new low! A book we have found to be far, far more helpful -- and just CHOCK full of organizational and study-habit info -- is "Learning to Learn" by Gloria Frender (Incentive Publications 2014).

I wish I had found this book earlier. My daughter struggles with organization and her grades suffered because of it. I bought this because it looked like a fun way for her to learn without being too preachy and more importantly she is able to follow along with the podcast. So far she likes listening and following along with the classroom antics and trying to figure out which student portrays her. I'm going to work with her this summer.
