

Great book.

This is a short book chock-full of information about elephants. Much of the information is a bit heavy on science, particularly the section on elephant communication (time of day, humidity, wind currents, and more are involved, for example). Most of the science is accessible, so it should not be a problem. Garstang is a scientist, but despite his professional objectivity in this book, he is also passionate about elephants. An unexpected plus is that Garstang included some of his pen and ink drawings of elephants, and they are extremely good, absolutely professional in quality. Don't expect a book of photographs--I did and was surprised. The photographs in the book are very good, but there are not many of them. The book has chapters on such things as evolution (this is the dullest part), morality, emotion, communication and more. Garstang blends anecdote and scientific reports (including some of his own). The book is equally good on the elephant brain and in describing elephant behaviors--which suggest superb memory, fairly complex social interactions, mourning, and that being an elephant is partly learned behavior. Discussion of elephant morality and ethics may seem to be over the top, but this is the best discussion I have seen on the subject, and the mix of scientific objectivity and reporting of telling anecdotes is quite unusual, and unusually interesting. Among other things that struck me, in a shotgun approach, are: The Angolan civil war killed hundreds of thousands of people, but also 100,000 elephants, and unsettled conditions are impacting elephants all over Africa. The prospect for elephant survival in Africa is not at all good. I was unaware that elephants are premier at seed dispersal--one study says one elephant in the

savanna distributes 2,000 seeds per hour, of very many species. There is some indication that elephants are in effect gardeners. Young male elephants may develop a buddy sort of relationship with older males, the younger elephant termed an "askari." Elephants seem to be able to detect land mines (millions are left over from the wars of the last generation), how is not known. Elephants seem to be able to hear low-frequency sounds made by storms or tidal waves, considerably before they hit, as was described by some survivors of the Sumatran tsunami. Other readers might be struck by other things. Garstang credits elephants with extraordinary hearing and excellent smell, and capable of a quite wide range of sound production. Alas, elephants captive in zoos have considerably shorter lives than those in the wild, which is sad because zoos are likely going to be the last places these wonderful animals exist.
