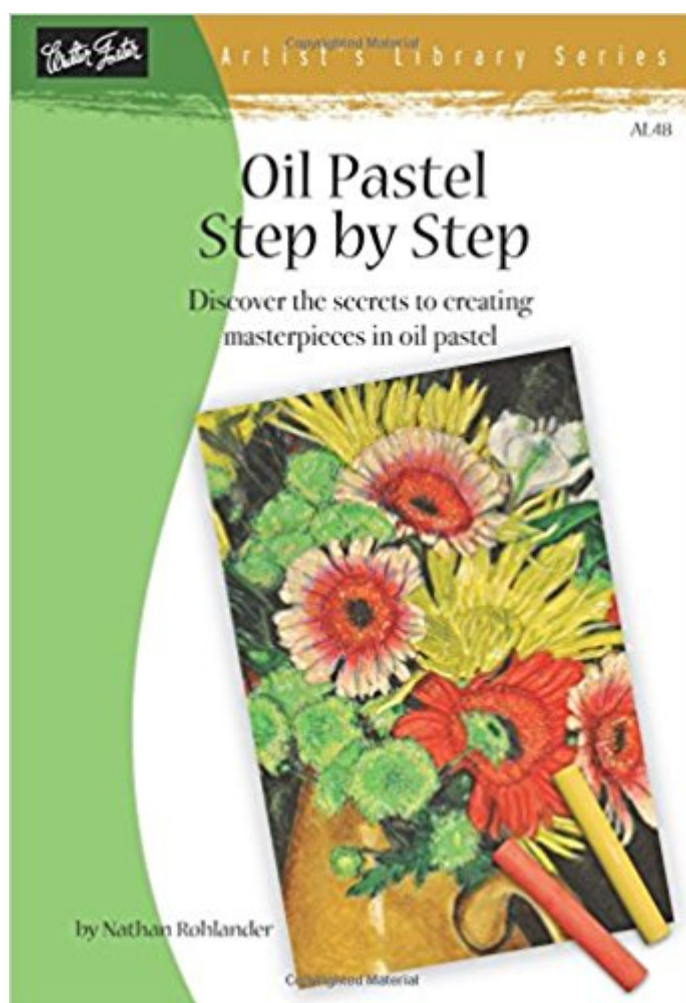

Nathan Rohlander's bright, vibrant paintings have been featured in the pages of Esquire and Shuz magazines, on the cover of Coast magazine, in Super Bowl commercials, in numerous television shows, and even in MTV videos. Having graduated with honors and a fine arts degree from the Art Center College of Design in Pasadena, California, Nathan is currently working toward a master of fine arts at California State University, Long Beach. Nathan lives and works in Los Angeles, but he has spent considerable time in Europe, South America, and Asia, where he has been able to gain creative inspiration and refine his global perspective. Nathan's work is featured in two Walter Foster Publishing titles: Acrylic: Still Lifes, in the How to Draw and Paint Series; and in The Artist's Source Book: 80 Acrylic Painting References. As an introduction, I think this book is okay, and it shows what can be done with an art medium that

many look down on (as they used to do with coloured pencil, and especially water-soluble pencil). This book does suggest some marks to make with oil pastels, but it doesn't give any advice for actually APPLYING the pastel. The author provides some examples of paintings that take you through his stages, in that you can see the paintings as they develop -- but he does not, and this is key -- share his actual PROCESS of creating them. This is a how-to book that should do more in terms of showing *how*, especially since oil pastels come in thick and clumsy sticks or rounds (I'm thinking in particular of Senneliens but Holbeins aren't much easier to create small areas of colour with). How does one achieve fine lines and precise detail with such a medium? It seems to me that this is absolutely essential, and the author doesn't address it. Where I also wish the editor had intervened is in the matter of defining categories. We are told that needed materials include 'matte medium' and 'gesso'. I am not new to art and yet I don't know what either material is, how to use it, or how it is useful to the oil pastel artist. A brief discussion of each material, rather than a mere listing, would have been more helpful.

I guess I shouldn't blame the book for failing to make an artist out of someone who doesn't have even one gene for Art!! It just seemed to me that the information in the book was far too advanced for someone who had never picked up an oil pastel in her life. The reason I gave it 3 stars is that it didn't seem to be for brand new beginners.
