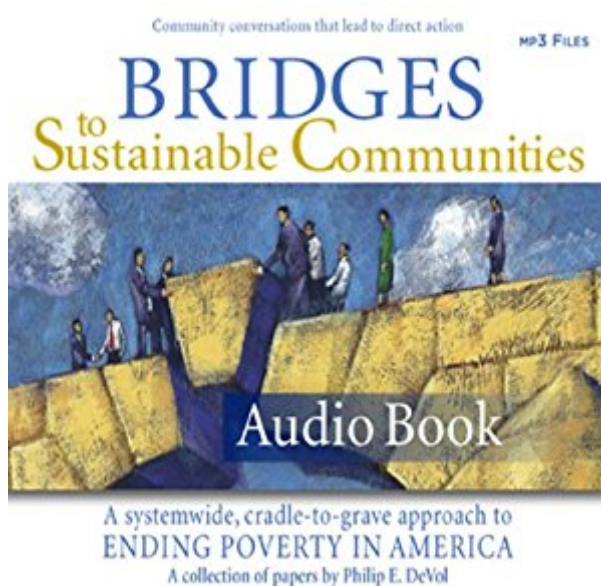


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Bridges To Sustainable Communities: A Systemwide, Cradle-to-Grave Approach To Ending Poverty In America
