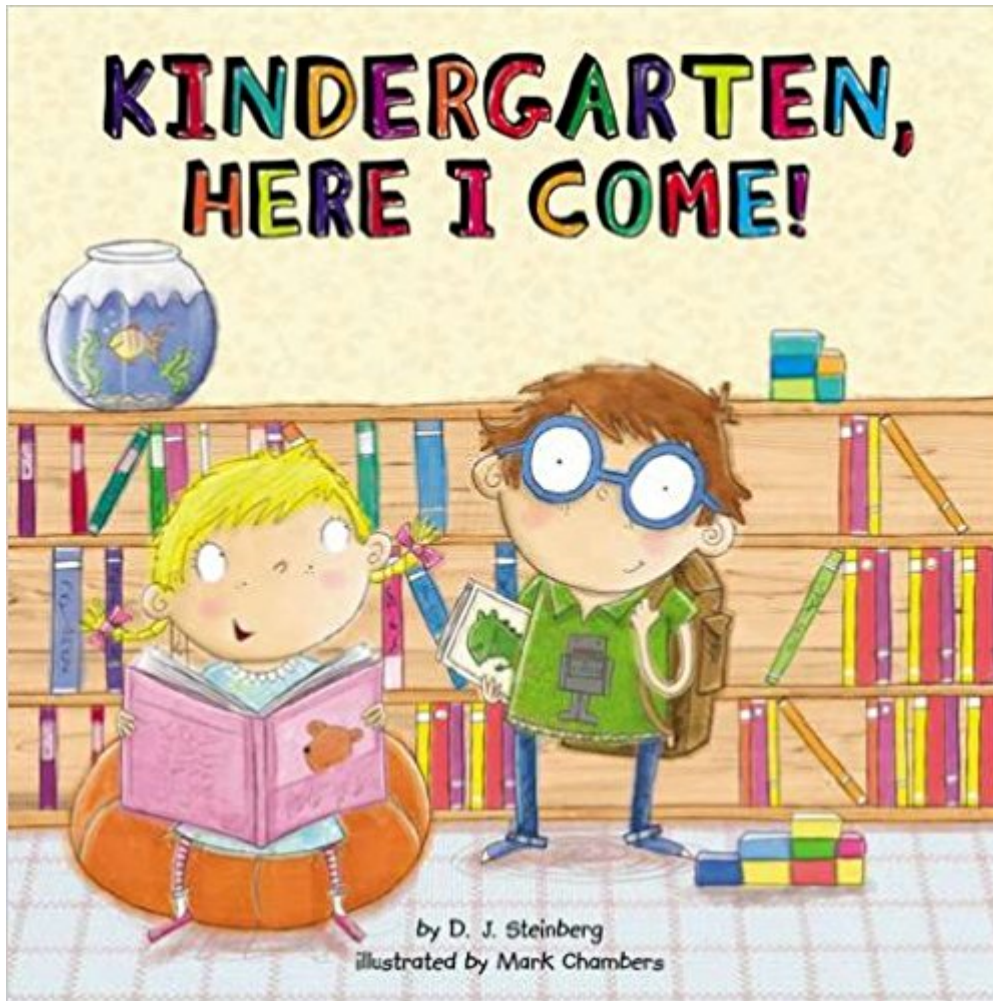




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Kindergarten, Here I Come!

I bought this for my son for a graduation present when he graduated VPK a few weeks ago. It is the perfect book to read to him about kindergarten. He is so excited to be going to kindergarten in the fall -- he absolutely loved this book! Would highly recommend to any VPK graduates!!

Really cute Kindergarten book written as a series of poems that highlight the first YEAR of school. Worth noting that this is less about the first day of school and it follows the boy as he progresses through his whole Kindergarten year. We love poem books so this was great. One thing to note is that in the book the children all take naps in Kindergarten. In my son's school at least, they do not

nap anymore at Kindergarten and this was a transition we were preparing him for. Worth noting before so you can address or skip that part if it is a sore subject.

It is a male main character, primarily, so she didn't totally relate to that, but overall it was a useful, calming guide.

Very cute set of poems that my 5 yo loved...especially the one about naps (although no more naps in kindergarten here...but still very cute) I will continue to read it to her throughout her year, as the poems talk about highlights throughout kindergarten...from the night before to the 1st day, to the 100th day, and even the last day. Glad I purchased for her.

My daughter loved this book before school started and she loves it even more now that she's in kindergarten. The only thing she can't relate to is nap time. The book does mention the boy being nervous and planning for a potential escape from kindergarten, and mom says it won't be too rough or something. Not wild about talking about any negatives to kindergarten, but overall it's a great book.

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
