

Soon Freedom dominated his thoughts and dreams, guiding him to fight for life. Eight months into his battle, Jeff learned that he was cancer-free. His first stop was Sarvey to walk Freedom. Somehow this special bird seemed to understand the significance of the day. For the very first time she wrapped both her wings around Jeff, enveloping him in an avian hug. This book confirms that in general there is a lot more to animals than previously thought. In this case the strong bond formed between the eagle who at first really needed his care and love and the author, Jeff Guidry. The eagle in turn helps him get through a very difficult time in his life when he has to fight cancer. He volunteered for a rescue mission and there are tales of other wounded creatures being rescued and often returned back to the wild when they have recovered. The eagle could never be returned to the wild because his wings had been broken badly so he never was able to fly and almost risked being euthanized. If you love animals, you will love this book.

An amazing story - even more so because it's a TRUE story. The book contains the spectrum of emotions - between very tragic and sad, to very uplifting and joyous.Jeff's (and his colleague's) DEDICATION to doing good for ALL the animals at the wildlife center is total. But the bond that developed between Jeff and Freedom is just WOW. During the life-or-death challenges both Freedom and Jeff went through, they helped each other - so heart-warming and REMARKABLE.
